SUBJECT: Amending Title 11, Chapter 110 - Coin-Operated Licenses

Coin-operated devices are one of many types of business licenses that are renewed annually. The July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015 business licensing renewal period has just concluded.

Village Code Title 11, Chapter 110, Section 110.21(C) states there shall be issued no more than the stated number of annual coin-operated licenses. These licenses are categorized into two Classes:

Class A - number of business establishments that have four to eight coin-operated devices on site. Class B – number of business establishments that have over eight coin-operated devices on site.

Currently, Lombard Moose Lodge, O'Neill's Pub, Otto's Bar & Grill and Sal's Pizza Pub all hold Class A licenses but have since decreased the number of their on-site coin-operated devices and no longer qualify to have a Class A license. Consequently the number of licenses in the Class A category needs to be amended from ten (10) to six (6).

As a housekeeping issue, there are currently only two (2) businesses that should hold a Class B license, Whirly Ball and Enchanted Castle, not three (3) as stated in Code. Village Code is being amended to reflect this.

Attached is an Ordinance decreasing the amount of Class A and B issued licenses to reflect the aforementioned circumstances. Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading in order to accurately reflect the current stated number of annual coin-operated licenses.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 110, SECTION 110.21(C) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO THE NUMBER OF CLASS A AND CLASS B COIN-OPERATED LICENSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 110, Section 110.21(C) of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(C) In addition to the license required by subsection (B) for each individual coinoperated amusement device, there shall be issued no more than the stated number of annual licenses in the following classifications for persons, firms, corporations or associations displaying for public patronage or keeping for operation any coin-operated amusement device:

Class A

Four to eight coin-operated amusement devices.

No more than ten six licenses.

Class B

More than eight coin-operated amusement devices.

No more than threetwo licenses.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
