# TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the "VILLAGE") has agreed to provide and install a decorative bicycle rack (hereinafter the "Bicycle Rack") at the northeast corner of the properties commonly known as 141 West St. Charles Road (P.I.N. 06-07-209-025) and 1 South Lincoln Avenue (P.I.N. 06-07-230-001 through 06-07-230-082) (hereinafter the "Subject Property"): and

WHEREAS, the owner of the Subject Property (hereinafter the "Owner") desires that the VILLAGE construct said Bicycle Rack and thereafter convey ownership of said Bicycle Rack to the Owner; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE needs a temporary easement over the Subject Property, at the location where the Bicycle Rack is to be installed, so as to be able to install the Bicycle Rack; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE has agreed to install the Bicycle Rack at no cost to the Owner; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE has agreed to restore the Subject Property to its preconstruction condition after completing the installation of the Bicycle Rack;

NOW, THEREFORE, MES LIAMATAS, as Owner of the Subject Property, hereby grants a temporary easement to the VILLAGE, and its officers, agents, employees and contractors, to facilitate the installtion of the Bicycle Rack on the Subject Property, with title to said Bicycle Rack, upon completion thereof, to be transferred to Owner, by the VILLAGE, pursuant to a Bill of Sale, with the Owner being thereafter solely responsible for the maintenance and repair of said Bicycle Rack, as owner thereof. This temporary easement shall expire one (1) year from the latest date set forth below, or upon completion of the Bicycle Rack installation and transfer of title thereto to the Owner, pursuant to a Bill of Sale, whichever occurs first.
