SUBJECT: Reduction of the number of Public Passenger Licenses

Village Code Title 11, Chapter 121 Section 121.03 (A) (2), currently states that: "There shall be six (6) (Public Passenger) Business Licenses issued by the Village. The Finance Department is requesting passage of an ordinance reducing the number of Public Passenger Licenses to three (3).

As of June 30, 2005, all Public Passenger (taxi) Licenses issued by the Village of Lombard expired. As of this date, three of the companies have not submitted a proper application for renewal, in accordance with Title 11, Chapter 121 section 121.03.

AAA Universal Taxi, Inc. had been shown by the Secretary of State as a dissolved corporation but subsequently produced the proper documentation of their corporate status "in good standing" from the Illinois Secretary of State's Office. However, they submitted an application with an incorrect corporate name. They have been notified in writing and by telephone about their application's deficiency and that they are to cease pickups of passengers in the Village until the matter is resolved, which has yet to be done as of today.

Auto Ride Cab Company to date has submitted no application or fee and have been notified both writing and by telephone to cease operations. Also, the Illinois Secretary of States office shows that Auto Ride Cab Company is a dissolved corporation. Title 11, Chapter 121.03 (A) (4) of the Lombard Village Code requires that a corporation be "qualified and licensed to transact business in the State of Illinois".

Citi-Suburban is also shown by the Illinois Secretary of State's Office as a dissolved corporation. Although they have told the Village that this situation has been rectified, the Village has received no confirmation to date from the Illinois Secretary of State's office that Citi-Suburban's status has been changed to "in good standing". They have been notified both in writing and by telephone that they are to cease doing business (picking up clients) in the Village.

Please present this request to the Board of Trustees for consideration at their July 21, 2005 meeting.

## ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 121.03(A)(2) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO PUBLIC PASSENGER LICENSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 121.03(A)(2) of the Lombard Village Code be amended to read as follows:

"(2) Number. There shall be three (3) Business Licenses issued by the Village. No additional Business Licenses shall be issued unless approved by the Board of Trustees.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form as provided by law. As your corporation has status of dissolved with the Illinois Secretary of State, you must cease operations for pickups in John "Jack" T. O'Brien, Dist. 3he Village of Lombard effective 12:01 a.m. today. Your drivers and company will be subject to citations and fines by the Lombard Police if found picking up passengers within the Village of Lombard. Two other taxi companies are presently in the same situation.

Also please be advised that your application is deficient for the following reasons:

Village Manager William T. Lichter The name of the business is shown as Citi-Suburban Taxi Co. on last year's application for your 2004/2005 license and with the Secretary of State. This year's application for 2005/2006 shows only Citi-Suburban Taxi. You must apply exactly the same way to be considered a renewal. The corporate name on your application should also be exactly as it appears with the Illinois Secretary of State.

Our ordinance requires that the names addresses and telephone numbers of the President and Secretary of the corporation be on the application.

Pursuant to Chapter 121, section 121.03 A (7) (f), in order to renew your license, we will need an application with the correct corporate name as was used last year, with information of both the President and Secretary included on the application and the same tax identification number, along with documentation that that corporation with those officers and the correct tax identification is a corporation in good standing with the office of the Illinois Secretary of State. If the application meets the qualifications for renewal, we will issue your 2005/2006 license. If it does not, it is to be considered a new licensee subject to the availability of licenses and approval by our Transportation and Safety Committee and the Village Board of Trustees.



SUBJECT: Reduction of the number of Public Passenger Licenses

On Thursday, July 14, 2005, Gordon Simik, President of AAA Universal Taxi, Inc. submitted a proper application to renew his Public Passenger License. With the application in order, his license has been renewed.

The renewal of his license in no way affects the status of item VIII JJ, which requests a motion to send the matter of the performance of AAA Universal Taxi, Inc. to the Transportation and Safety Committee.

On Monday, July 18, the Secretary of State's office posted notification that Citi-Suburban is a corporation in good standing and as such they are eligible for renewal on their Public Passenger License.

Auto Ride Cab Company still has not renewed, expressed any desire to renew and is a corporate status of dissolved according to the Secretary of State's records.

Attached please find a revised ordinance reducing the number of Public Passenger licenses by one instead of three.

## ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 121.03(A)(2) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO PUBLIC PASSENGER LICENSES

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 121.03(A)(2) of the Lombard Village Code be amended to read as follows:

"(2) Number. There shall be five (5) Business Licenses issued by the Village. No additional Business Licenses shall be issued unless approved by the Board of Trustees.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
