Subject:

Olde Town Additional Stop Signs

Olde Town is an area from Main St. to West Rd. and St. Charles Rd. to Greenfield Ave. Over the past 3 years, all the streets in Olde Town have been reconstructed. In the past, stop signs have been added to address traffic concerns at certain locations. Out of the 11 intersections in this area, only 4 intersections do not have traffic control devices.

Elizabeth and Grove are offset; property damage has been reported on the northwest corner. Both eastbound and westbound on Grove, as you approach Elizabeth, vehicles are traveling out from a curve. This makes it difficult for drivers on Elizabeth to drive through the intersection without stopping.

The other intersections are "T" type intersections. Parking is allowed on these streets, causing some degree of poor sight distance for the driver at these intersections.

To provide safety and consistency throughout the area, I would recommend installing the following stop signs (see attached map):

- Eastbound Eugenia at Elizabeth.
- North and southbound Elizabeth at Grove.
- Northbound Orchard Terr. at Grove.
- Eastbound Windsor at Park.
