Subject: FY 2024-2025 Season Road Salt Purchase

The Village participated in DuPage County Department of Transportation's salt bid. Bids for this contract were opened May 14, 2024. Morton Salt, Inc. was the lowest bidder with a per ton cost of \$73.90 and will be the provider of bulk road salt for the County's contract. The Village is able to purchase bulk road salt under this contract from the provider without any additional costs.

Under the terms of the contract, staff would like to exercise the option of purchasing up to 100% of the requested 4,000 tons of salt to replenish the salt that was used during the 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 seasons. Village staff excercised the option to not participate in the contract for the 2023-2024 when salt prices were high.

The Village has approximately 3600 tons of salt in reserve in the salt storage dome. The Village can begin to accept deliveries of salt under the 2024-2025 contract in October 2024.

Salt purchase of \$295,600.00 will be paid for by the MFT fund 420.730.730.73310 in FY 2024-2025.
