ORDINANCE	

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 120, OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO TOBACCO DEALER'S LICENSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 120, Section 120.16 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising paragraphs (C) and (D) as follows:

- "(C) Compliance by New License Holders. All new tobacco dealer's license holders who obtain a tobacco dealer's license subsequent to July 1, 2007, shall be given four (4) months, from the date of issuance of the tobacco dealer's license to come into compliance with Subsections A and B above relative to the Tobacco Program requirement.
- (D) Compliance After Loss of a Certified Management Employee. Any tobacco dealer's license holder, who, due to the loss of a management employee who has successfully completed the Tobacco Program, is put in a position of non-compliance with Subsection A above, shall have four (4) months to come into compliance."
