ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND A NEW CLASS "Q" LIQUOR LICENSE CATEGORY

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding language thereto, relative to a new Class "Q" liquor license category, to read in its entirety as follows:

"Class "Q" -- Package sales of wine only at a Farmers Market, from June 1st to September 15th, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The sales can take place no more than once per week, for a period of no more than four (4) hours; and
- (2) Providing samples/tastings of the wine shall be allowed."

SECTION 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding language thereto, relative to a new Class "Q" liquor license category, to read in its entirety as follows:

"Class "Q" – 0"

SECTION 3: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.14(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding language thereto, relative to a new Class "Q" liquor license category, to read in its entirety as follows:

"Class "Q - \$250 per Farmers Market season (June 1st to September 15th)"

SECTION 4: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.14(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended as follows:

- A. That the parenthetical phrase after the entry relative to the Class "J" liquor

license, as contained therein, is revised by changing the reference to "except Class "P," as noted below," to read, "except Classes "P" and "Q," as noted below."

- B. That the parenthetical phrase after the Application Fee, as contained therein, is revised to read in its entirety as follows: "(Except for Class "J" and Class "P," which shall have no Application Fee, and Class "Q," which shall have a \$100 Application Fee)."

SECTION 5: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.16 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the parenthetical phrase, as contained therein, to read in its entirety as follows: "(with the exception of Classes "J," "P" and "Q")."

SECTION 6: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
