The attached ordinance increases the number of Class A Coin Operated Amusement Device licenses from five to six.

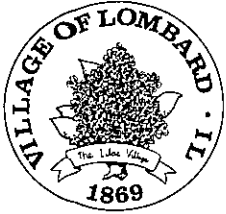

SUBJECT: Amendment to Chapter 110, Section 110.21(C) of the Lombard Village Code in Regard to the Number of Coin Operated Amusement Device licenses.

As provided for by the ordinance governing the licensing of coin operated amusement devices, attached is an ordinance that amends the number of approved Class A licenses (four to six devices) from five (5) to six (6).

This increase in licenses is the request of O'Neill's Pub, located at 236 E. St. Charles Road, to license five (5) devices.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 110, SECTION 110.21(C)
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO THE NUMBER
OF AUTHORIZED COIN-OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICE LICENSES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 110, Section 110.21(C), of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“(C)In addition to the license required by Subsection (B) for each individual coin-operated amusement device, there shall be issued no more than the stated number of annual licenses in the following classifications for persons, firms, corporations or associations displaying for public patronage or keeping for operation any coin-operated amusement device:

Class A

Four (4) to six (6) coin-operated amusement devices
No more than six (6) licenses.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
