The Private Engineering Services Division of the Community Development Department recommends that the Board of Trustees accept the public watermain and fire hydrants at 305 - 352 Yorktown (Shops on Butterfield). The stated improvements are acceptable as they were installed substantially to plan and have passed all required tests. The Private Engineering Services Division has approved the project record drawings.
