AT 305 - 352 YORKTOWN (SHOPS ON BUTTERFIELD), IN
LOMBARD, ILLINOIS**

The Private Engineering Services Division of the Community Development Department recommends that the Board of Trustees accept the public watermain and fire hydrants at 305 - 352 Yorktown (Shops on Butterfield). Attached is the updated utility map. Please present the attached resolution to the Board of Trustees at their February 16, 2012 meeting.

The stated improvements are acceptable as they were installed substantially to plan and have passed all required tests. The Private Engineering Services Division has approved the project record drawings. The on-site sanitary sewer, fire suppression and water service lines, and the storm sewer will remain the responsibility of the property owner.

The extensive delay in accepting these improvements was from the length of time necessary to finalize the public watermain easements with Yorktown Mall that were recently accepted by the Board at their February 2, 2012 meeting.
