Ordinance for Modifying Existing Parking Limitations in the Olde Towne East Neighborhood

The Transportation and Safety Committee voted to endorse an Ordinance that would replace current No Parking at any time restrictions on Windsor Avenue and Charlotte Street with a less restrictive one hour parking limitation between the hours of 7 am and 10 am.

Ordinance for Modifying Existing Parking Limitations in the Olde Towne East Neighborhood

On-street parking within the Olde Towne East neighborhood is either limited to one (1) hour between 7 am and 10 am due to the close proximity to the Metra Train Station, or is prohibited anytime. The attached map demonstrates these current parking restrictions, along with two (2) restricted parking locations that are no longer necessary. Specifically, the No Parking Zone on the east side of Charlotte Street between St. Charles Road and Grove Street is listed in the Traffic Code as both No Parking anytime and one (1) hour parking between 7 am and 10 am. To correct this discrepancy, one of the parking restrictions must be removed. Since there is no known reason to restrict parking after 10 am at this location, elimination of the No Parking at anytime restriction is recommended. Also, the No Parking zones on both sides of Windsor Avenue between Martha Street and Craig Place were enacted to regulate vehicles specifically attributed to Allied Drywall from congesting traffic and idling during early morning hours. Recently, the road was widened, the specified business is no longer operating, and two (2) local residents have requested removal of the existing parking restrictions. Therefore, it is recommended to modify the existing parking restriction at this location to be consistent with the one (1) hour parking limitation as instituted throughout the remainder of the neighborhood.

On January 3, 2011, the Transportation and Safety Committee voted to recommend the following modifications to the Village Traffic Code.

SCHEDULE VII – PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS

In accordance with Section 10-13-6 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall, at any time, park a vehicle upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:

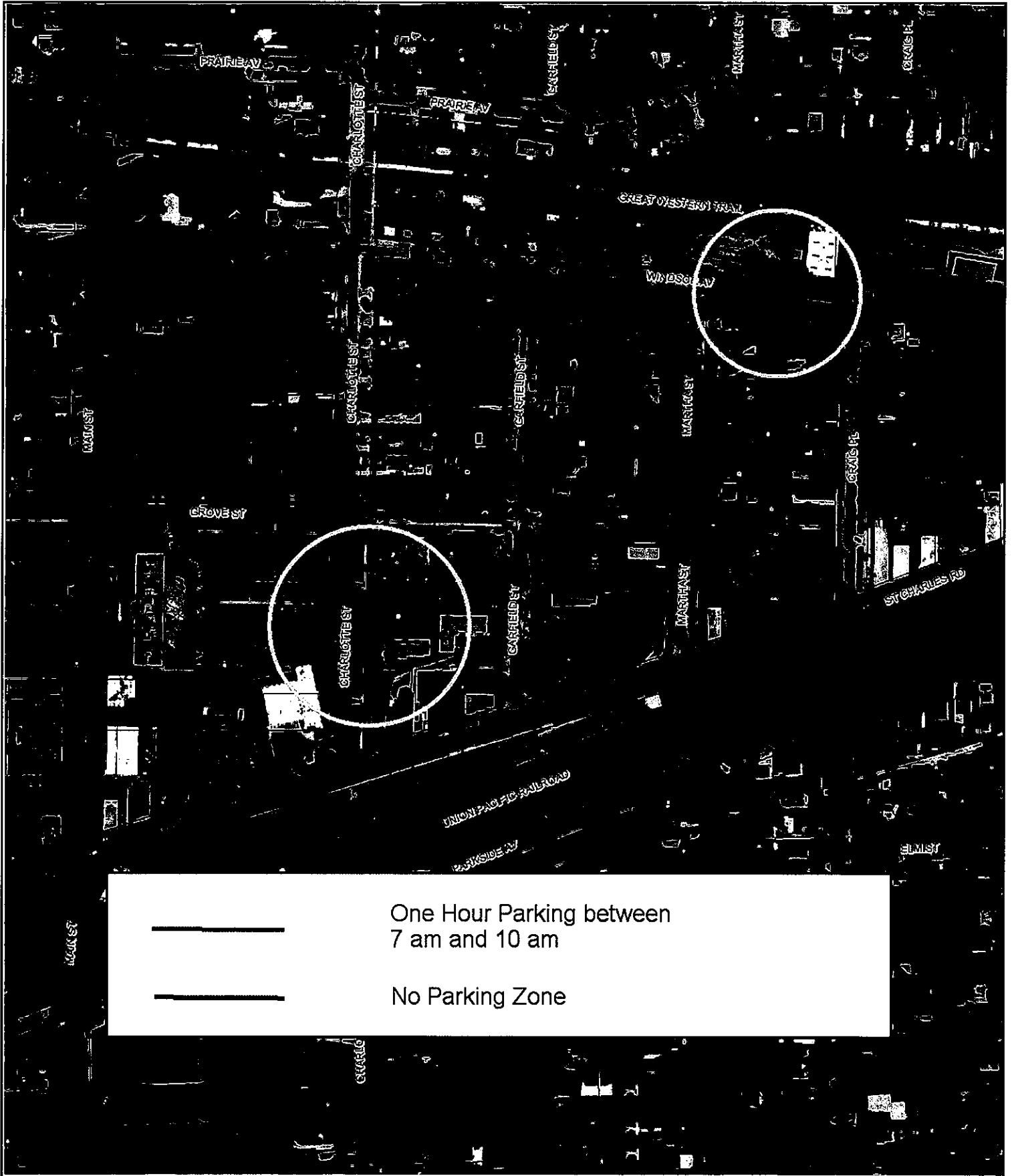

ORDINANCE NO. _____

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule VII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS be amended to delete the following therefrom:

| <u>Name of Street</u> | <u>From</u> | <u>To</u> |

| Charlotte St., East side | A point 135 ft north of the north right-of-way of St. Charles Rd. | Grove St. |
| Windsor Ave., Both sides | West curb line of Craig Place | East curb line of Martha St. |

Section 2: That Schedule X (a) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS (one hour between the hours of 7:00 am and 10:00 am) be amended to add the following thereto:

| <u>Name of Street</u> | <u>From</u> | <u>To</u> |

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
