Tree Consortium Bid waiver

On August 4, 1988, the Village Board approved participation in the Suburban Tree Consortium. Representing 37 member communities, this organization handles the tree planting bid process in accordance with State of Illinois law. As a member, the Village must commit to a lead-time of five years for the purchase of trees grown based upon projected orders for trees.

\$10,000.00 is currently budgeted for parkway tree planting for FY11/12. This figure represents approximately 30 trees that will be planted in the Fall 2011 and Spring 2012 planting seasons. As a formality, the Village Attorney has recommended waiving bids and approval of this payment.

On March 18, 1999, the Village Board approved the planting of parkway trees through the Consortium on Capital Improvement Projects as part of projects in the CIP budget. However, there are no trees scheduled to be planted as part of the CIP.

The Suburban Tree Consortium provides top quality trees grown specifically for parkway conditions. We have received a superior product in the past and recommend waiver of bids in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 for trees from the Suburban Tree Consortium.
