No Parking at the Intersection of Stewart Avenue and  $17^{\rm th}$  Street

The Village received a request to investigate a concern of parked vehicles at the intersection of Stewart Avenue and 17<sup>th</sup> Street. Though no vehicles were parked at the subject location during staff's site inspection, it was evident a parked vehicle could block the line of sight for drivers traveling north or west. The situation is depicted on the attached exhibit. Therefore, to be consistent with Section 155.207 of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance (line of sight), a No Parking Zone is recommended as follows:

SCHEDULE VII – PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS		
In accordance with Section 10-13-6 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall, at any time, park a vehicle upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:		
Name of Street	From	То
Add: 17 <sup>th</sup> Street, both sides	The western right-of-way line of 16 <sup>th</sup> Place	The intersection of Stewart Avenue
Add: Stewart Avenue, both sides	The intersection of 17 <sup>th</sup> Street	A point 100 feet south.
