Subject: FY24 Vehicle Replacement, asphalt recycler & hot box trailer

The FY2024 budget includes replacement of a Falcon recycler & hot box trailer from the Public Works Street and Electrical Group. The Falcon unit performed well and fulfilled the needs of the department throughout its lifecycle and was determined by staff as preferred replacement.

The trailer is available for purchase through the Illinois state CMS contract # 23-416CSM-BOSS4-B-33802 from Midwest Paving Equipment (MPE) of Glen Ellyn, IL.

Staff recommends the Board of Trustees wave bid and award a contract to MPE of Glen Ellyn (IL) in the amount of \$38,292 at the May 2nd meeting.
