Results of the "Snow and Debris Hauling Contract PWO 1303"

On Friday, December 7, 2012, bids were opened for the Snow and Debris Hauling Contract. Bid specifications were sent to eight (8) vendors, resulting in two (2) bidders responding who met Village specifications. The bid results are as follows:

The contract would be in effect for a one year period from January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013 with a potential extension for one additional year at the Village's sole discretion. The scope of work includes trucking for wind-row operations from the downtown, removal of spoils from Village excavations, and material hauling for the Village.

The Public Works Department has checked with the current customer list provided by Nagle Trucking and have received excellent reviews on their performance. Therefore the Public Works Department is recommending that Nagel Trucking be awarded a contract for Snow and Debris Hauling Contract in the amount not to exceed \$41,340.00 for the period of January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013.
