- Bonds required to guarantee performance and payment for labor and material for this work shall be 5. in a form acceptable to the Village and shall provide that they shall not terminate on completion of the work, but shall be reduced to ten percent (10%) of the contract sum upon the date of final payment by the Village for a period of one (1) year to cover a warranty and maintenance period which Contractor agrees shall apply to all material and workmanship for one (1) year from the date of issuance of the final payment by the Village.
- Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of the Mechanics' Lien Act of Illinois, prior to making any 6. payment on this contract the Village demands that the Contractor furnish a written statement of the names of all parties furnishing labor and/or materials under this Contract and the amounts due or to become due on each. This statement must be made under oath or be verified by affidavit. Final payment shall not be issued by the Village nor shall any retained percentage become due until releases and waivers of lien have been supplied as the Village designates.
- In executing this Contract, Contractor agrees that it has examined the site of the work and the 7. conditions existing therein, has examined the Contract Documents and taken and compared field measurements and conditions with those Documents.
- This Contract represents the entire Agreement between the parties and may not be modified without 8. the written approval of both parties.
