Subject: Waiver of Bid for LED Luminaires and Ameron Light Poles

On September 23, 2009, the Village received an Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant in the amount of \$187,500. This grant will be used to replace 119 existing high pressure sodium luminaires with energy efficient LED luminaires. Additionally, as part of the project, eight (8) 19'6" light poles will be removed and replaced with 14'1" poles to match the other poles in the project area.

Requests for proposals for the purchase of 119 Sternberg LED Luminaires and eight (8) Ameron Concrete Direct Burial Light Poles were sent to seven (7) vendors and following are the results:

The proposals for LED Luminaires and Ameron Light Poles came in slightly higher than expected at \$170,318.00. The Public Works Department is recommending that PJD Sales, Inc. be awarded a contract for supplying luminaires and light poles in an amount not to exceed \$170,318.00. Although the costs came in over estimates, the grant the Village received will cover the cost of these items.
