SUBJECT: **Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A)**
Claim Jumper Restaurant – 92 Yorktown

Claim Jumper Acquisition Company LLC d/b/a Claim Jumper Restaurant currently holds a Class "A/B-III" liquor license. Village Code Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.18(D) states that a liquor license shall terminate whenever 50 percent or more of the ownership interest changes from that shown on the original license application. Village staff was recently informed of a change in the ownership interest of Claim Jumper Acquisition Company LLC that would require the current liquor license being terminated and a new liquor license being applied for.

Attached is an ordinance decreasing and increasing the Class "A/B-III" category by one to reflect the ownership change.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading to reflect these changes.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B-III" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-III" - 13

This decrease in the number of Class "A/B-III" liquor licenses reflects a change in the ownership interest of Claim Jumper Restaurant, located at 92 Yorktown, and the termination of the Class "A/B-III" liquor license issued to Claim Jumper Acquisition Company LLC in relation thereto.

Section 2: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B-III" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-III" - 14

This increase in the number of Class "A/B-III" liquor licenses reflects the issuance of a new Class "A/B-III" liquor license to Claim Jumper Acquisition Company LLC d/b/a Claim Jumper Restaurant located at 92 Yorktown, Lombard, IL.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
