Subject: Vista Pond Overflow

In order to make future overflow pumping operations at Vista Pond more efficient, the Public Works Department proposes contracting with the John Neri Construction Company, Inc. of Addison, IL for the purpose of installing two manholes on an abandoned storm sewer crossing the Union Pacific Railroad tracks and connecting it to the storm sewer on the Chase Ave. south of the tracks that flows to Gatz Pond.

This connection will enable Village crews to use portable pumps to assist normal pumping operations when the pond elevation is at flood level without running over 800 feet of discharge hose. The pumps will be set up when needed, and monitored by Public Works crews to ensure that the downstream sewer system is not overloaded. The connection will utilize a portion of the old storm sewer system that tied into the combined sewer on Chase south of the tracks. The sewer has to be rerouted to the storm system since the sewer on Chase is now a separated sewer.

The establishment of this overflow will reduce the time and labor costs to establish the overflow under the Union Pacific Railroad tracks. Under the current overflow scenario, the village crews have to manually set up and tear down the 800 feet of pipe, which takes approximately 40 hours, much of the work performed on an overtime basis. The proposed overflow will reduce the costs and the timeframe to start the overflow pumping operation.

John Neri Construction, Inc. has submitted a proposal in the amount of \$23,900.00 to complete the installation of 2 manholes, 50 ft. of ductile iron pipe and connecting to the storm manhole. The Village will remove the trees on Chase and restore the pavement and landscape. This work will be paid for out of the Water & Sewer Capital Fund Underground Structures Project.

Christopher B. Burke Engineering, Ltd. (CBBEL), who has been retained to study Vista Pond, has reviewed the proposed connection and according to their computer model, the additional flow should not adversely impact the storm sewer tributary to Gatz Pond and the combined sewer system downstream from Gatz Pond. This proposed connection will be included as an existing condition in the CBBEL analysis of Vista Pond infrastructure and will not preclude any additional improvements that may mitigate future flooding.

John Neri Construction Company, Inc. is qualified to perform the work and has performed satisfactorily in the past. They currently have a contract with the Village to perform Emergency Water & Sewer Repairs. Therefore, I am requesting the Board of Trustees

award a contract in the amount not to exceed \$23,900 to the John Neri Construction Company, Inc. at the March 19, 2009 meeting.

The Public Works Committee was briefed on the issue at their March 10, 2009 meeting. The item was presented to the Committee as part of a discussion of recent storm events, but not presented as a formal action item on the agenda. The Committee concurred with the proposed improvement, but did not take formal action relative to this project. The Committee has requested that this improvement be incorporated into the CBBEL Vista Pond work effort, which is anticipated to be presented to the Committee at the April 14, 2009 meeting.
