SUBJECT: Ordinance Amending Title 9, Chapter 97.200

Background

The Village Code provides a permit process for overweight and/or over-dimensioned vehicles utilizing Village roadways. The permit process allows the Lombard Police Department to ensure that overweight or over-dimension vehicles utilize roadways that are appropriately designated/designed for the movement of large equipment. The permit process contained in §97.200 of the Lombard Code does provide an exemption to the permit process. The Code exempts the following vehicles or movements from the permit process:

1. Fire department vehicles;
2. Those vehicles operating under an emergency declaration;
3. Village owned vehicles engaged in emergency utility repair;
4. Equipment used for snow and ice removal owned or operated by any governmental body.

As part of the Public Works Department standard specifications for the contracting out for services for construction activity, the department requires contractors to obtain overweight/over-dimension permits when applicable. Contractors obtain the permit through the Lombard Police Department and pay any required fees. Contractors include the fee in their proposal, which in essence means that the Village is paying a fee to itself. The Public Works Department would like to amend §97.200 (A) to provide for an additional exempt that would eliminate the permit fee for contractors working on a public works project on behalf of the Village of Lombard. Contractors would still be required to obtain a permit; however, the fees would be waived.

Recommendation

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE IX, CHAPTER 97, SECTION 97.200 (A)
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO PERMITS REQUIRED
FOR THE MOVEMENT OF OVERWEIGHT AND/OR OVER-DIMENSION
VEHICLES ON THE STREETS OF LOMBARD**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title IX, Chapter 97, Section 200 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding the following to the end thereof:

“Exempt from permits are the following:

1. Fire department vehicles;
2. Those vehicles operating under an emergency declaration;
3. Village owned vehicles engaged in emergency utility repair;
4. Equipment used for snow and ice removal owned or operated by any governmental body;
5. Equipment owned and operated by a private contractor used in the construction of public works for the Village of Lombard.”

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
