SUBJECT: Ordinance Amending Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code - Famous Liquor - 105 E. Roosevelt Road

D P Liquor Inc. d/b/a Famous Liquor currently holds a Class "F" liquor license. The primary purpose of the establishment is the sale of alcoholic liquors as a package store. The Village of Lombard has received notice from the landlord that the current license holder, D P Liquor Inc., is not renewing their lease and consequently, will no longer be operating Famous Liquor.

Concurrently, the Village of Lombard has received a request from the prospective new tenants, Shakti 11 Lombard Inc. d/b/a Famous Liquors for a Class "F" liquor license to operate at the same location. Attached is an ordinance decreasing and increasing the number of Class "F" licenses by one to account for the new tenants.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading in order to accommodate the closing date between the existing and new tenants and also due to the cancellation of the June 5, 2014 Village Board meeting.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 (A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "F" liquor license category, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "F" – 4

This decrease in the number of Class "F" liquor licenses reflects the ceasing of business by D P Liquor Inc. d/b/a Famous Liquor, and the termination of the Class "F" liquor license issued to D P Liquor Inc. in relation thereto.

Section 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "F" liquor license category, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "F" – 5

This increase in the number of Class "F" liquor licenses reflects the issuance of a Class "F" liquor license to Shakti 11 Lombard Inc., who will be operating the business commonly known as Famous Liquors, located at 105 E. Roosevelt Road, Lombard, IL.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
