120624; Ordinance to Add Traffic Control Devices on Arboretum Drive

The intersections of Arboretum Drive with Lincoln and Edson Streets are uncontrolled. Due to these intersections' configurations, approaching vehicles to either of these intersections may find it difficult to determine which roadway is primary or secondary; thus, making it difficult to apply the governing right-of-way rule. Per the MUTCD, placement of a YIELD sign is warranted in these situations. Attached is a location map and copy of the Temporary Placement of Traffic Control Device regulation, which temporarily authorized the installation of yield signs at the subject locations.

On December 3, 2012, the Transportation and Safety Committee voted to recommend the following modification to the Traffic Code, which establishes these traffic control devices permanently.

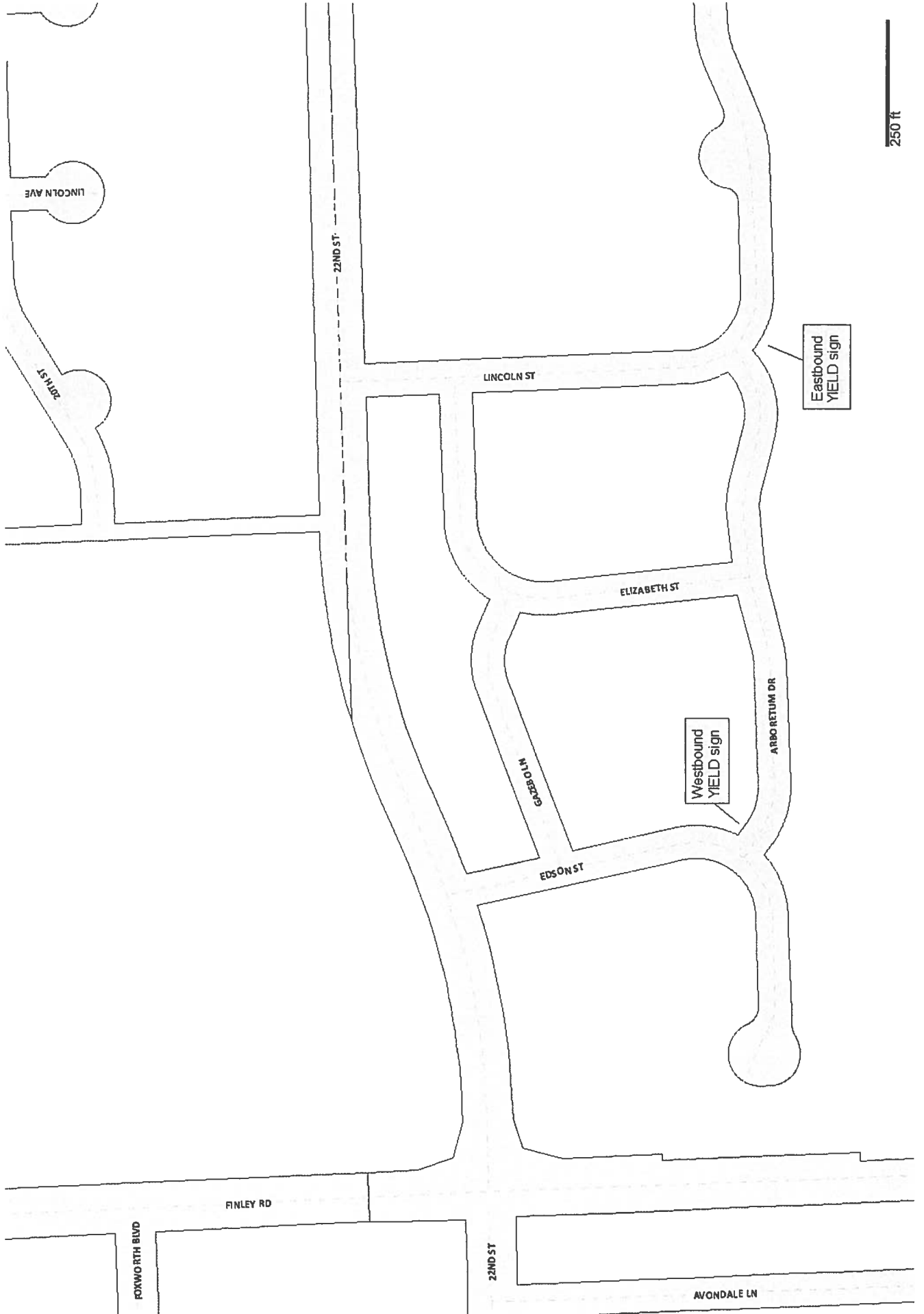
SCHEDULE V – PREFERENTIAL STREETS

In accordance with Section 10-9-5 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, drivers of vehicles shall yield the right-of-way to the following streets at the intersections designated.

ADD: Arboretum Drive (westbound) will yield to Edson Street and Arboretum Drive.
ADD: Arboretum Drive (eastbound) will yield to Lincoln Street and Arboretum Drive.

AUTHORIZATION FOR TEMPORARY OR EMERGENCY PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL REGULATION OR DEVICE

Pursuant to the Village of Lombard Traffic Code, section 10-3-8, the below listed temporary or experimental regulation is authorized as an emergency or special condition: (please specify)

The intersections of Arboretum Drive with Lincoln and Edson Streets are currently uncontrolled. Due to these intersections' configurations, approaching vehicles to either of these intersections may find it difficult to determine which roadway is primary or secondary; thus, making it difficult to apply the governing right-of-way rule. Per the MUTCD, placement of a YIELD sign is warranted in these situations.

Temporary placement of YIELD signs on eastbound and westbound Arboretum Drive at Lincoln and Edson Streets are recommended (see attached map).

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule V of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PREFERENTIAL STREETS, be amended to add the following hereto:

"Arboretum Drive (westbound) will yield to Edson Street and Arboretum Drive."
"Arboretum Drive (eastbound) will yield to Lincoln Street and Arboretum Drive."

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
