100136; Ordinance to Establish a No Parking Zone on Madison Street

On April 5, 2010, the Transportation and Safety Committee discussed vehicular sight distance issues and safety concerns at the intersection of Hammerschmidt Avenue and Madison Street at the end of each school day. Specifically, the Village currently employs a crossing guard to serve the Hammerschmidt School at the intersection of Madison Street and Hammerschmidt Avenue. Hammerschmidt Avenue, being a one-way north-bound street during school days, exhibits a surge in the amount of traffic between 2:30 pm and 3:30 pm due to parents picking-up their children from school. Consequently, parents that arrive early will queue/park on the south side of Madison Street, immediately east and west of the Hammerschmidt intersection. The queued/parked vehicles obstruct the view of north-bound traffic from Hammerschmidt Avenue, causing a visual impairment for both drivers and the crossing guard.

The Committee voted to recommend prohibiting parking on the south side of Madison Street, 85 feet in either direction of Hammerschmidt Avenue between the hours of 2:30 pm and 3:30 pm on school days. A map of the proposed No Parking Zones is presented for your consideration. This action requires an ordinance to the Traffic Code as follows.


