SUBJECT: An Ordinance Declaring Village Property as Surplus and Authorizing its Sale and/or Trade-In.

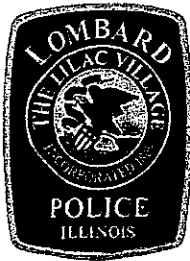

BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS: This Ordinance declares the police department's currently owned handguns as surplus property and authorizes their trade-in to Kiesler's Police Supply towards the purchase of new handguns. This ordinance ratifies the approval of the Village Board which was obtained through a telephone poll during the last week of May. A waiver of first reading is being requested.

Re: Ordinance to Declare Police Department Handguns as Surplus and Authorizing Their Trade-In

The Police Department's 2013 budget had funds which were approved to purchase new handguns for all sworn personnel. For the last 20 years the police department had used Sig Sauer pistols. Given their reliability, the new handguns purchased in 2013 also came from Sig Sauer. Once the new handguns were deployed however, we began to experience problems with them on the range. This included ammunition misfeeds, weapons jamming and failing to fire. We endeavored to work through the problems with the manufacturer, but found their customer service to be lacking. More importantly, sworn personnel began to lose confidence in the reliability of the handguns.

Given these circumstances, both range and management staff concluded that the proper course of action was to replace the handguns with new ones from a different manufacturer. All personnel were recently allowed to test fire Glock pistols on our range and found them to be suitable. We located a Glock distributor through Kiesler's Police Supply. Kiesler's Police Supply has agreed to accept all of our current Sig Sauer pistols on trade-in and replace them with Glock pistols with no additional costs. In fact, they are giving us a \$500.00 credit towards the purchase of leather goods as we will have to purchase new holsters and ammunition pouches. They have the guns in stock and are ready to deliver them.

The police department desired to move expeditiously on this matter given the officer safety concerns. However, to complete the trade-in, the Village Board would need to declare the currently owned handguns as surplus. This ordinance will in effect ratify the actions the police department has taken to hasten the trade. A phone poll was conducted of the Village Board members seeking their approval to move forward with the transaction while allowing the ordinance to be approved at the next meeting (June 19, 2014). All members of the Village Board agreed to proceeding as outlined above. The favorable passage of this ordinance on first reading is respectfully requested.
