- 1. This contract shall embrace and include all of the applicable contract documents listed below as if attached hereto or repeated herein:

 - Required Performance and Payment Bonds and Certificate(s) of Insurance for Contract ST-08-01
 - d. Executed Bidder's Certification Form for Contract ST-08-01
- 2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment as shown on the Contractor's Proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.
- 3. The Contractor shall commence work under this Contract upon written Notice to Proceed from the Village and shall complete work on this project within 15 calendar days from the date of the Notice to Proceed. Time is of the essence of this Contract and Contractor agrees to achieve completion within the contract time by all proper and appropriate means including working overtime without additional compensation.

- Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of the Mechanics' Lien Act of Illinois, prior to making any payment on this contract the Village demands that the Contractor furnish a written statement of the names of all parties furnishing labor and/or materials under this Contract and the amounts due or to become due on each. This statement must be made under oath or be verified by affidavit. The Village shall not issue final payment nor shall any retained percentage become due until releases and waivers of lien have been supplied as the Village designates.
- This Contract represents the entire Agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.
