Subject: Rebuild Well #11 High Service Pumps & Motors – Waiver of Bids

The Village maintains four wells that can provide an average day's water supply should the DuPage Water Commission (DWC) not be able to provide the Village water. The wells are tested and operated monthly to ensure operational readiness. However, during the monthly test operations, the wells are pumped to waste and not into the distribution system per the DWC Charter Customer Agreement.

Well #11 is a shallow well that requires not only a well pump and motor but also high service pumps to supply water to the water distribution system. The well pump and motor were rebuilt in 2088. This project consists of inspecting and rebuilding the two (2) high service pumps and motors, including replacing deteriorated frames and concrete bases to ensure the high service pumps will safely operate in an emergency situation.

Staff contacted four (4) companies to get quotations on this work and three (3) submitted proposals:

GENCO Industries, Crestwood, IL	\$43,900.00
Dreisilker Electric Motors, Glen Ellyn, IL	\$21,480.00
Budget Estimate	\$35,000.00

Dreisilker Electric Motors has performed work for the Village and their work was satisfactory. Therefore, I am requesting the Board of Trustees waiver bids and award a contract to Rebuild Well #11 High Service Pumps & Motors to Dreisilker Electric Motors, Inc. of Glen Ellyn, IL, in an amount not to exceed \$21,480.00 at their September 5, 2013 meeting.
