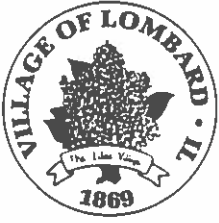

Subject: FY2016 Vehicle Replacement

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The FY 2016 budget includes replacement of a Public Works Street Division street sweeper (a 2003 Elgin Pelican, unit # ST377). Since the lead time to build this sweeper is approximately 4 months staff would like Village Board authorization to place the order now which would allow delivery for the spring sweeping season.

The replacement Elgin Pelican sweeper is available for joint purchase through the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC). The current contract winner for the SPC is Standard Equipment Company of Chicago (IL). The quoted price for the sweeper with options is \$197,484. Standard Equipment is offering a \$10,000 trade-in allowance for our old sweeper however staff would like to first try and auction this sweeper. It has been staff's experience that the open market will bring a higher return compared to trading in. The budgeted amount for this purchase is \$200,000 (\$180,000 in reserve plus salvage).

I recommend the Board of Trustees award a contract to Standard Equipment Company of Chicago (IL) in the amount of \$197,484 for a new Elgin Pelican street sweeper as optioned on the attached proposal. I also recommend declaring village unit number ST377 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorize its sale. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the December 17, 2015 meeting.
