**BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:**

The attached Resolution would allow the Village President to sign an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Village of Glendale Heights. The Agreement clarifies the roles and responsibilities of both Villages for the provision of an additional police liaison officer at Glenbard East High School. School District No. 87 is desirous of having a Glendale Heights police officer serve as a police liaison officer in all three Glenbard schools that have Glendale Heights students in attendance (North, West and East high schools). The additional officer would rotate between all three schools. All costs for the additional officer are being paid for by District 87.
