Subject: Roosevelt Road Watermain Lining – West Contract

The Roosevelt Road Watermain Lining – West Contract project area includes: Roosevelt Road from Finley Road to Fairfield Avenue. The project involves the lining of approximately 6500 feet of existing watermain with a structural liner. The project involves a temporary by-pass watermain, service connections, new fire hydrants, and restoration.

Seven (7) potential bidders and subcontractors purchased bid documents. Public Works - Engineering received one (1) and read one (1) bid at 11:00 A.M. on May 21, 2013. Bid results are summarized below:

Company	Bid
Fer-Pal Construction USA, Inc.	\$2,699,558.00
Engineer's Estimate	\$2,100,044.50

Due to the number of pay items the bid tabulation is not attached. Staff will provide copies upon request and it will be posted on the Village website after award of the contract. Please contact me if you want a copy of the bid tabulation, have any questions or need any additional information.

As a result of receiving a bid that could be questioned as to the reasonable cost of particular items, staff is of the opinion that the contract should be negotiated with the contractor to reduce the cost of those items. Staff is recommending that the Board reject all bids and have staff negotiate an acceptable contract with the low bidder.
