Berkshire Ave. and Charlotte St. Stop Sign Installation

The intersection of Berkshire Avenue and Charlotte Street is currently controlled by a temporary Stop sign on Berkshire Avenue. Committee members stated the temporary Stop sign is ineffective intersection control due to the temporary nature of the sign operation.

During the January 13, 2014 meeting, the Transportation and Safety Committee voted to recommend changing the temporary Stop sign installation to a permanent Stop sign installation at Berkshire Avenue/Charlotte Street and to update the Village ordinance at the above intersection.

Ordinance No.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule IV of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled STOP STREETS is amended to delete the following hereto:

"Charlotte Street shall stop at Berkshire Avenue"

Section 2: That Schedule III of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled STOP INTERSECTIONS is amended to add the following hereto:

"Berkshire Avenue and Charlotte Street"

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
