Modify: Schedule XIII – Right Turns on Red Traffic Signals

g) All four corners: Main Street and 22nd Street (7:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. & 2:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on School Days).

Eliminate the time restriction and replace it with "When Pedestrians are Present".

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule XIII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled RIGHT TURNS ON RED TRAFFIC SIGNALS be amended to read as follows:

g) All four corners: Main Street and 22nd Street, when pedestrians are present

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
