**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE CVS

WHEREAS, the Private Engineering Services Division of the Village of Lombard has certified the completion of the public fire suppression line, fire hydrant, sidewalk and parkway trees installed for the CVS Pharmacy development project and has recommended said improvements be accepted; and

SECTION 2: That the storm sewer outside of the public right of way and the stormwater detention basin are to remain the responsibility of the property owner.

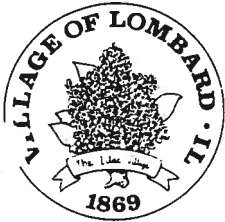
