**Ordinance for Modify Parking Limitations at the 300 S. Block of Westmore-Meyers Road**

Currently, parking is restricted to two (2) hours on the west side of Westmore-Meyers Road from Division Street to the south property line of the Illinois Prairie Path. This 300 south block of Westmore-Meyers Road is zoned B2. With all available retail space being occupied, the businesses compete for the limited parking spaces located on Westmore-Meyers Road.

Several months ago, representatives of the Public Works and Police Department met with each business owner at this location. It was the consensus of the business owners that a limited number of parking spaces being restricted to ten (10) minute parking could assist with patron parking availability. On November 19, 2010, a temporary ten (10) minute parking limit was authorized by the Police Chief and Director of Public Works for two (2) parking stalls located on the west side of Westmore-Meyers Road, between the northern right-of-way line of Division Street and a point 65 feet north (see attached). After 30 days, the business owners were pleased with the results and a permanent modification to the parking limitation sought. On January 3, 2011, the Transportation and Safety Committee voted to recommend the following modifications to the Traffic Code.

**SCHEDULE X – PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS**

(d) In accordance with Section 10-13-10 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for a period exceeding two hours between the hours of 8:00 am and 6:00 pm on any day except Sundays and holidays in any of the following places:

<b>Delete:</b> Westmore Ave., both sides right-of-way	Division Street	South property line of the Prairie Path
<b>Add:</b> Westmore-Meyer Rd., East side, right-of-way	Division Street	South property line of the Prairie Path
<b>Add:</b> Westmore-Meyer Rd., West side, right-of-way	A point 65 feet north of the Division Street northern right-of-way	South property line of the Prairie Path

(H) In accordance with Section 10-13-10 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for a period exceeding ten minutes in any of the following places:

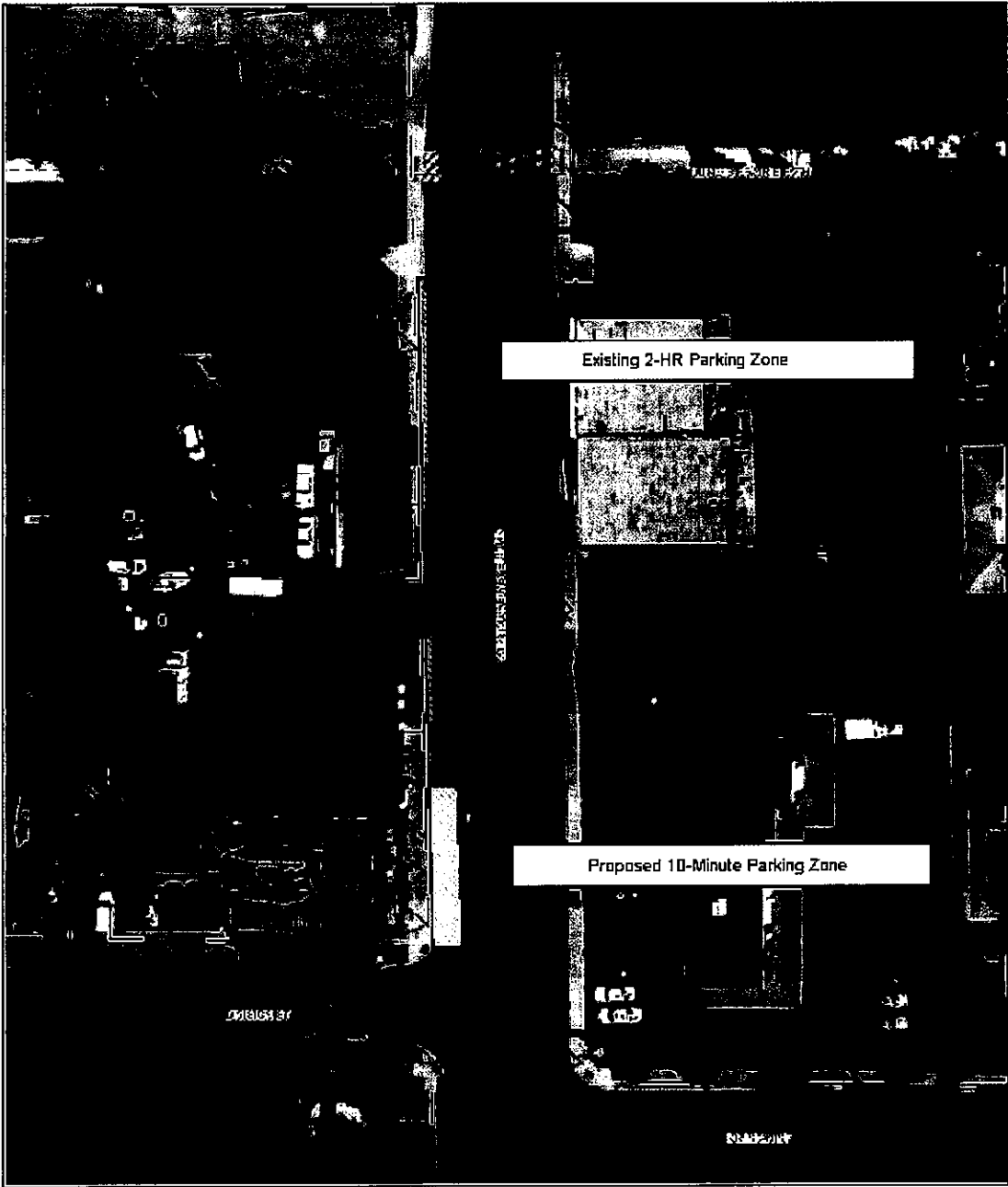

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE**

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule X (d) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS (two hours between the hours of 8:00 am and 6:00 pm) be amended to delete the following therefrom:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
Westmore Ave. Both sides right-of-way	Division St.	South property line of the Prairie Path

Section 2: That Schedule X (d) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS (two hours between the hours of 8:00 am and 6:00 pm) be amended to add the following thereto:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
Westmore-Meyer Rd., East side, right-of-way	Division St.	South property line of the Prairie Path
Westmore-Meyer Rd., West side, right-of-way	A point 65 feet north of the Division St. northern Right-of-way	South property line of the Prairie Path

Section 3: That Schedule X (h) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS (for a period not to exceed ten minutes) be amended to add the following thereto:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
Westmore-Meyer Rd., West side, right-of-way	Division St. northern right-of-way	A point 65 feet north of the Division St. Northern right-of-way

Section 4: That Schedule XXI (a) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled NO MINIVAN, VAN, TRUCK OR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKING ON PREFERENTIAL STREETS be amended to delete the following therefrom:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
Westmore-Meyers Rd. West side	North curb line of Division St.	A point 130 feet north

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
