- 22nd & Finley SW corner
- Main & Madison NW corner
- Main & Hickory by former Mr. Z's
- Main & St. Charles SW corner
- St. Charles & Elizabeth NE & SE corners
- Roosevelt and Fairfield by Buona Beef
