SUBJECT: Correction to Scrivener's Error – Sign Ordinance: Temporary Signs

BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS

In 2013, the Plan Commission recommended and the Village Board adopted Ordinance 6834, which amended the Sign Ordinance as it relates to temporary inflatable signs (PC 13-04). These amendments were intended to update the Sign Ordinance to allow temporary inflatable signs to incorporate text or graphics. Previously, the Sign Ordinance prohibited the display of text or graphics on inflatable signs.

Ordinance 6834 amended Section 153.209, Attention-Getting Devices, to provide for text and graphics on inflatable signs and attention-getting devices. Related definitions in Section 153.602 were also amended. Unfortunately, Ordinance 6834 as adopted did not amend a table in Section 153.237 of the Sign Ordinance that contains a reference to inflatable signs and pennants with a footnote that prohibits graphics or text on these signs. In review of the Plan Commission public hearing testimony, it is clear that the intent of the text amendment was to allow for display of text and/or graphics on inflatable signs and pennants, and that the table in Section 153.237 should have been amended accordingly.

To correct this scrivener's error and per Village Counsel direction, the Village is requesting a text amendment to Section 153.237 as follows:

§153.237 TEMPORARY SIGNS.

(D) Permitted temporary signs by sign type and property type: Temporary Signs shall be allowed in the Village in accordance with the following table:

Y = Allowed without sign permit.

ii = No text, graphic, logo or symbol shall be displayed on any surface.

ACTION REQUESTED

Attached is an Ordinance approving a text amendment to Section 153.237 of the Lombard Sign Ordinance, to correct a scrivener's error associated with Ordinance 6834. AN ORDINANCE APPROVING TEXT AMENDMENTS TO THE LOMBARD SIGN ORDINANCE TITLE 15, CHAPTER 153 OF THE CODE OF LOMBARD, ILLINOIS

(Correction of a Scrivener's Error – Temporary Signs)

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard maintains a Sign Ordinance which is found in Title 15, Chapter 153 of the Code of Lombard, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees adopted Ordinance 6834 on May 2, 2013 that intended to amend the Sign Ordinance to allow text or graphic symbols to be displayed on temporary inflatable signs and other attention-getting devices; and

WHEREAS, in further review of the adopted Ordinance, the Village finds that the Ordinance inadvertently failed to amend a table in Section 153.237 that prohibits text or graphics on inflatable signs and pennants; and

WHEREAS, the Village finds that this oversight was unintended and did not reflect the intent of the Plan Commission through its public hearing process and the Village Board in its approval; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees find it appropriate and necessary to adopt an amended ordinance to reflect the intent of the Plan Commission and Village Board in its original approval of the text amendments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That title 15, Chapter 153, Section 153.237, of the Code of Lombard, Illinois is hereby amended to read in part, as follows:

§153.237 TEMPORARY SIGNS.
