Subject: Geotechnical Engineering, Construction Material Testing

Testing Services Corporation (TSC) of Carol Stream, Seeco Consultants (Seeco) of Tinley Park and Terracon Consultants (Terracon) of Naperville have performed commendably on the Geotechnical Engineering and Construction Material Testing Services Contract in FY 2012B. It is recommended that the Village exercise its option to renew the current agreements for FY 2013. This contract fulfilled its primary function of establishing continuity of service, simplifying contracting procedures and reducing Village staff time associated with contract document preparation and administration. The FY 2012B fee schedule (for all three consultants) will remain in place for FY 2013.

The Village needs to allocate a professional services contract budget for FY 2013 related to the Capital Improvement Program. The total not to exceed contract budget amount for FY 2013 (January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013) will be a total of \$150,000.00. The total budget amount will be distributed among the three (3) consultants. The amount per consultant will depend upon which is selected as the "most qualified" to perform the associated work for a particular project. As such, while the entire budgeted amount is being authorized to possibly be spent with any one of the three (3) consultants, it is probable that the total budgeted amount will be expended with all three (3) consultants. The total expenditures among the three (3) consultants will not exceed the authorized budget of \$150,000.00. Programmed Capital Improvement Projects in FY 2013 involving geotechnical engineering, construction material testing or environmental services are listed below.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 720, Section 5/33E-9, units of local government are required to make specific findings prior to authorizing any amendment relative to a contract which would increase or decrease the dollar amount of the contract by \$10,000 or more, or would extend or shorten the time in which the contract is to be completed by thirty (30) days or more; and

WHEREAS, staff has presented and recommended the proposed amendment to the contract between the Village of Lombard and Terracon Consultants, Inc. regarding the Geotechnical Engineering, Construction Material Testing and Environmental Services Contract, as attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made part hereof, (the "Amendment") to the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard; and
