BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

The Lombard Police Department is requesting cleaning up the language so that it reflects that village stickers can be adjudicated through Chapter 73. Although Chapter 73 currently states, village sticker violations can be locally adjudicated, the current language in Chapter 70 reflects fines if going to the circuit court. Officers now have the option of sending the violators through the adjudication process or through the circuit court.
