120246; Ordinance to Add Parking Restrictions on Hickory Road

The homeowners on a section of Hickory Road between Elizabeth Street and Park Road have petitioned the Village to adopt a limited parking restriction in their area. For the past several years, these residents have been observing an increasing number of transient vehicles parking in front of their homes for extended hours (likely commuters) and an increase in litter. These stated problems are similar to the other sections of the Village that previously experienced commuter parking issues before the Village Traffic Code was modified to discourage commuter parking availability in neighborhoods. Coincidentally, all roads between this section of Hickory Road and the Metra Station are posted with a limited one hour parking restriction between the hours of 7 am and 10 am.

The petition was signed by 59% percent of the properties affected. Attached are the petition and a map of the area for your reference. On October 1, 2012, the Transportation and Safety Committee voted to recommend the following modification to the Traffic Code.

SCHEDULE X – PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS

(a) In accordance with Section 10-13-10 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for a period of time exceeding one hour between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 10:00 A.M. on any day except Sunday and holidays in any of the following places:

To the VILLAGE OF LOMBARD for a PARKING RESTRICTION on the north and south sides of Hickory Road from Elizabeth Street to a point 600 feet west (the 200 block of W. Hickory).

PURPOSE: Hickory Road is a residential street. For the past several years, a small number of passenger vehicles have been parking at the above location without much impact to our neighborhood. However, the number of vehicles utilizing the permitted on street parking has increased to as many as ten (10) on any given weekday. These vehicles remain all day, from 7 am to as late as 10 pm, do not exhibit Village of Lombard stickers, and are not doing business at any of our residences. The presence of garbage/litter has also increased in our gutters.

REQUEST: To permit parking on Hickory Road for residents while reducing the amount of transient parking. We, the undersigned, wish to petition the Village of Lombard for limiting PARKING to one hour between 7 am and 10 am on any day except Sundays and Holidays at the above referenced location.
