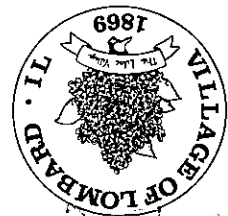

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11,
CHAPTER 112 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of
Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village
Code is amended to read as follows:

“Class “E-1” – Alcoholic beverages dispensed from a portable bar within a
private party room as an adjunct to a sports and fitness center, or a
recreational center not covered by a Class “M” or Class “R” liquor license,
for consumption on the premises only; no package sales allowed. Said
party room shall be open to individuals twenty-one (21) and over.”

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its
passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
