FY11 State Bid Vehicle Purchase

Included in the FY 2011 budget is the replacement for Village unit number WT472, a 2003 John Deere backhoe. State bid for this type of vehicle has been awarded to West Side Tractor of Naperville (IL), contract number 4015566. The base contract price for the backhoe is \$53,978 plus \$34,008 in additional options equals a total price of \$87,986. Trade-in allowance for our old backhoe is \$28,000 so the net cost of this purchase would be \$59,986. Budgeted amount for this purchase is \$70,000.

I request the B.O.T. to waive bid, and award a contract to West Side Tractor of Naperville (IL) in the amount of \$59,986 for a new John Deere backhoe. I also recommend declaring Village unit number WT472 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its trade-in. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the February 18, 2010 meeting.
