BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:



The Private Engineering Services Division of the Community Development Department recommends that the Board of Trustees accept the public water main and fire hydrant at 333 Eisenhower Lane South (DVD Investments). Attached is the updated utility map. Please present the attached resolution to the Board of Trustees at their November 20, 2008 meeting.

The stated improvements are acceptable since they were installed substantially to plan and have passed all required tests. The Private Engineering Services Division has approved the project record drawings. The on-site sanitary sewer, fire suppression and water service mains, and the storm sewer and detention system will remain the responsibility of the property owner.

The required easement over the stormwater detention system was previously approved.





We recommend acceptance by the Village President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard.



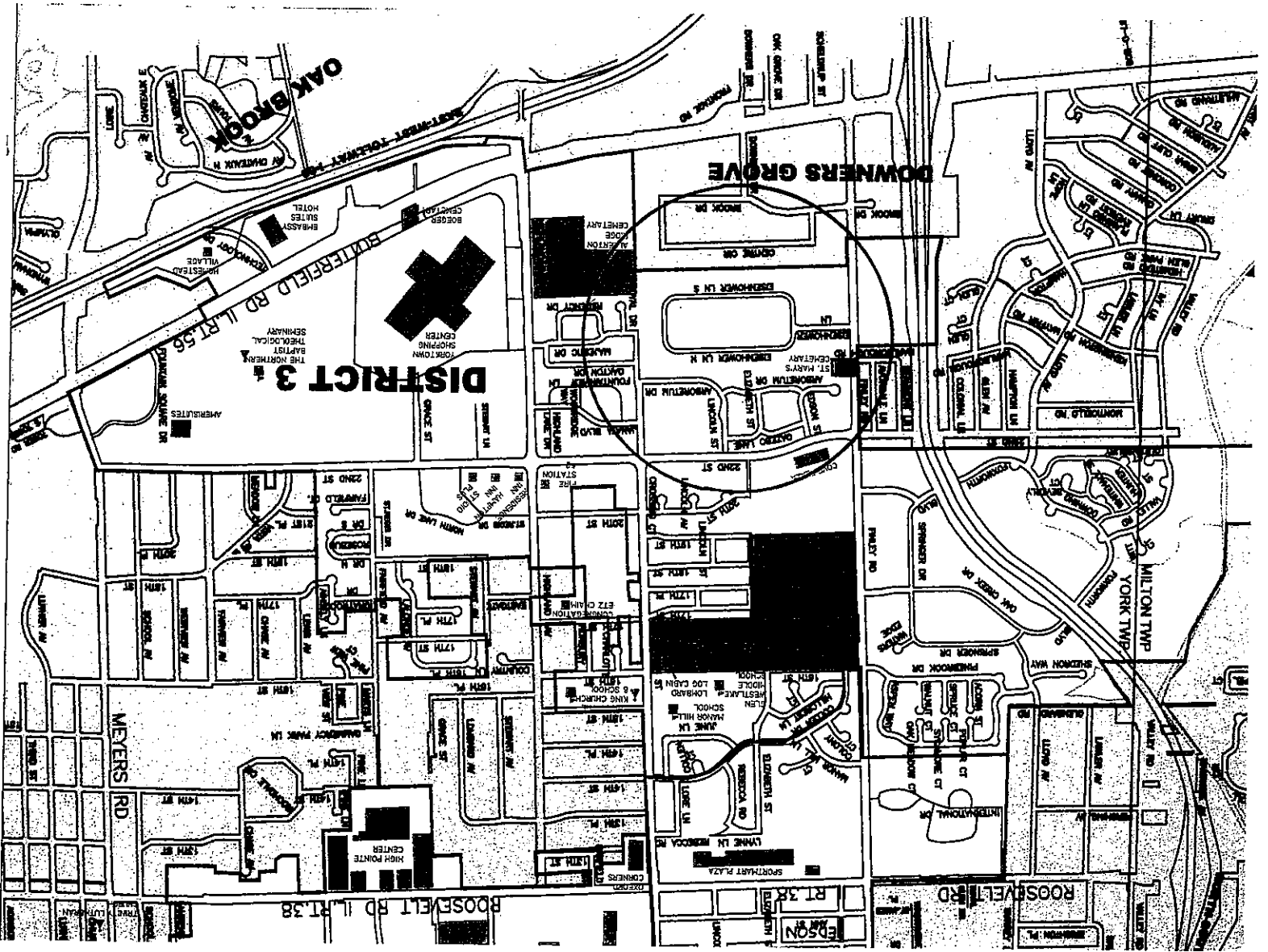


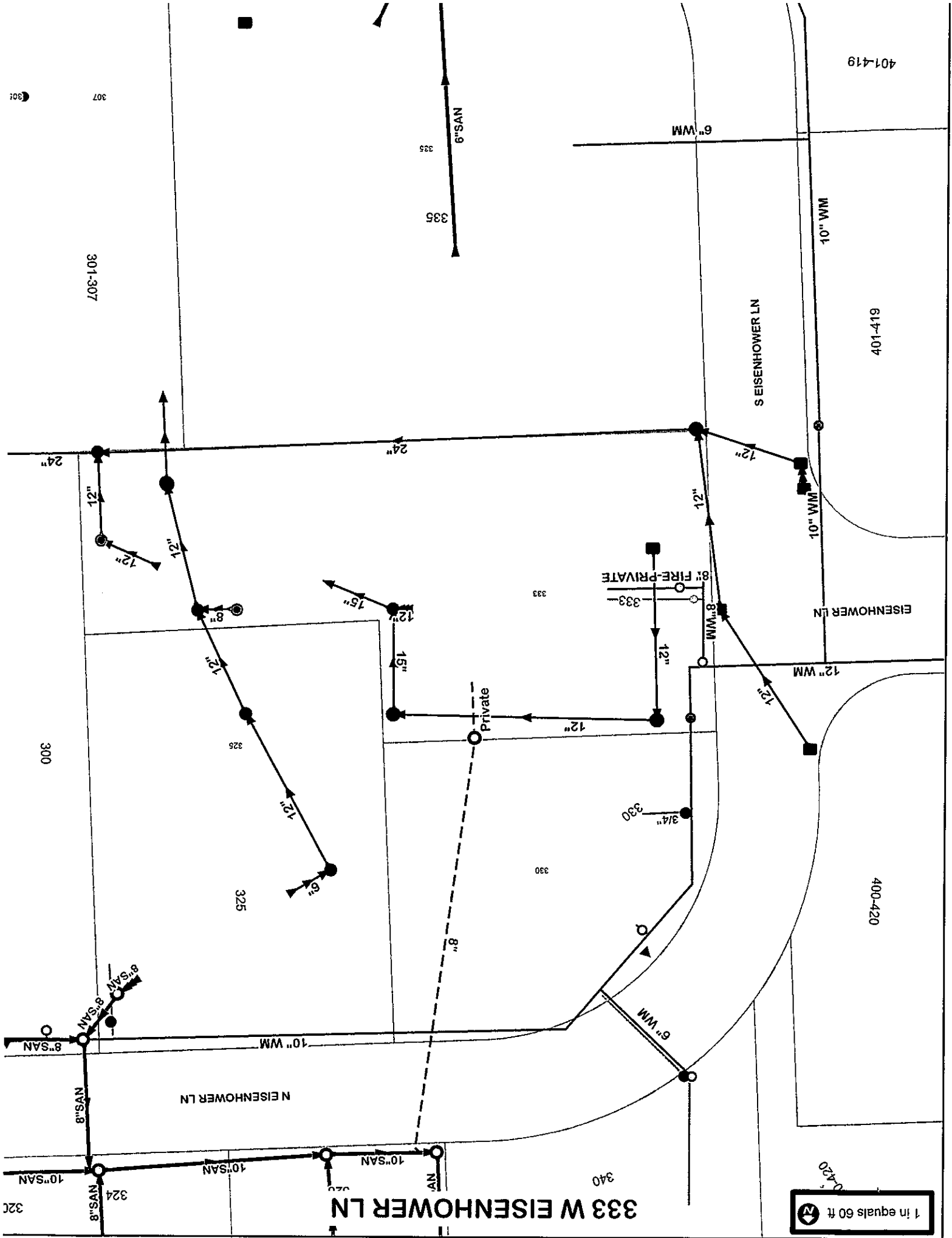
