ComEd Pole Relocation

It will be necessary for Commonwealth Edison (ComEd) to relocate the power lines in the Great Western Trail right-of-way and across the UP Railroad rightof-way. ComEd has estimated the project to cost \$422,000. Initially, the Village will need to give ComEd an advance deposit of \$42,200 to complete the engineering for the project, which will be credited to the relocation cost once the project begins.

This work is included in the Great Western Trail Bridges project estimate. The relocation of the ComEd facilities was originally estimated at \$120K by the design engineer. Based on a preliminary review by ComEd it was determined that the electric lines needing relocation were more extensive and due to the voltages involved would be a much higher cost to deal with. With the Grade Crossing Protection Fund funding the Village's portion of the cost is still within available funding limits for the project. Utility relocation associated with the railroad grade separation will be funded at 60% Grade Crossing Protection Fund (\$253,200) and 40% Village TIF 2 Fund (\$168,800). Staff recommends approving the Advance Deposit Agreement for Engineering in the amount of \$42,200.00.

Please present this Advance Deposit Agreement for Engineering to the President and Board of Trustees for their review and approval at the next meeting, June 16, 2011. If approved, please return one signed original to Public Works-Engineering for further processing.

RE: Advance Deposit for Engineering

This letter is in response to your request for relocation of electric lines on THE GREAT WESTERN TRAIL, EAST OF GRACE ST., IN LOMBARD. Based on the preliminary information that you have provided to ComEd, it has been determined that your project will require installation, relocation, or removal of facilities that are above 'standard' – that is, facilities that are more than provided for in the basic service covered in ComEd's rates. An 'optional facilities payment' is required from the customer in such situations. The optional facilities payment amount due can only be determined upon completion of the engineering and design plans for your project.

To complete the detailed engineering and provide contracts with the actual optional facilities payment due for your project, ComEd requires a non-refundable deposit in the amount of \$42,200.00. This deposit will cover the engineering costs associated with your request to relocate electric lines. The preliminary scope of this work includes the removal of 4 poles, the installation of 3 poles, and the replacement of 6 poles to re-route the line to the Northern boundary of the Great Western Trail.

If you would like ComEd to complete the final design and prepare the necessary contract documents for your project, please sign below and return this letter along with the required deposit amount within 30 days to 1N423 Swift Rd, Lombard, IL 60148.

If you ultimately decide to move forward with this project, the advance deposit for engineering will be credited against the final optional facilities payment amount. If you choose not to proceed with the work, the deposit will be retained by ComEd to cover the engineering costs associated with your project. If you have requested multiple design options, you will only receive a credit for the option that you choose to authorize for construction.

If this signed letter and deposit payment amount are not returned within 30 days, ComEd will consider your request for service cancelled.


