BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

Request for 4 Way Stop Signs at N. Park Ave and W. Grove St.

The temporary stop signs on N. Park Ave. at W. Grove St. were recently removed after their term had expired. The basis for their installation had been sight line reductions created by construction equipment being parked on the roadway. Construction equipment no longer creates the sight line reduction. The police department undertook a traffic study after the signs were removed based on a significant amount of resident feedback. The study concluded that the intersection met conditions necessary for the installation of permanent stop signs on N. Park Ave at W. Grove St. The matter was heard before the Public Safety and Transportation Committee at their monthly meeting. The committee voted to permanently install the stop signs based on staff's recommendation as well as public participation at the meeting.
