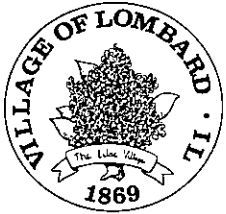

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entries relative to the Class A/B-I liquor license category, contained therein effective July 1, 2004, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-I" – 5

Section 2: That the change in the number of Class A/B-I liquor licenses set forth in Section 1 above, is a result of granting a liquor license to Johnson's Door County Fish & Shrimp, Inc. doing business as Johnson's Door County Fish & Shrimp located at 908 E. Roosevelt Road, Lombard which has recently been annexed into the Village.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
