Water Meters - Declare Surplus

The Department of Public Works has a couple of hundred water meters ranging in size from 5/8" to 4" that have been removed from the water system over the past 4 years that can not be reused or refurbished for various reasons. The meters have value as scrap. The last time meters were sold as scrap was in 2006. The revenue gained from the sale of the meters will be deposited in the Water & Sewer Operating Fund Revenue Meter Sales account (5100.604660).

Public Works has received proposals from two companies:

The meters being scrapped have been removed from the system by Public Works and are independent from the meters being replaced as part of the FY11 Automated Meter Replacement Project. The contract with HD Waterworks provides for a credit for each meter scrapped as part of the project.

I am recommending the Board of Trustees declare the unused water meters in Public Works inventory surplus and give Public Works the authority to sell the water meters to the highest bidder, Global Meters of Texas.
