SUBJECT: **Amendment to Title 3, Chapter 30, Section 30.24 (Transportation and Safety Committee)**

In 2008, the Village of Lombard created the Lombard Circulator Task Force. The task force was charged with creating a strategy for implementing the service plan, including how to fund, operate, market, and monitor the proposed circulator service. Per Section 30.21 of the Code of Ordinances, the proposed Task Force disbanded upon acceptance of the Task Force's final report by the Corporate Authorities. This report was presented and accepted on April 2, 2009.

As staff continues to work with DuPage Mayors and Managers Conference and the Village of Addison to implement the circulator, it is anticipated that a standing committee will need to review and make recommendation to the Village Board regarding the operation of the circulator. Based upon its task to consider and make recommendations regarding transportation and safety, staff believes that the Transportation and Safety Committee would be the most appropriate standing committee to review issues associated with the circulator.

RECOMMENDATION

Please place this item on the September 3, 2009 Village Board agenda for consideration. Staff recommends that the Corporate Authorities approve an Ordinance amending Title 3, Chapter 30, Section 30.24 (F) to allow the Transportation and Safety Committee the responsibility of reviewing, reporting upon and making recommendations on issues associated with the Circulator.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 30,
SECTION 30.24 (F) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard maintains a Code of Ordinances, which is found in the Code of Lombard, Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, Title 3, Chapter 30, Section 30.24 (F) of the Code of Lombard, Illinois includes provisions regulating the duties and responsibilities of the Transportation and Safety Committee; and,

WHEREAS, the Village is establishing a Village-wide Circulator to serve and supplement the public transportation needs of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Village believes that the Transportation and Safety Committee would be the most appropriate standing committee to review issues associated with the Circulator.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 3, Chapter 30, Section 30.24 (F) of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended as follows.

§ 30.24 Duties.

(F) Transportation and Safety Committee. The Transportation and Safety Committee shall consider and make recommendations to the Corporate Authorities regarding:

(1) Transportation. The Committee shall have the responsibility of reviewing and reporting upon all methods and forms of transportation affecting the Village, including both public and private methods of transportation.

(2) Safety. The Committee shall review and make recommendations to the Corporate Authorities regarding traffic and safety matters in the Village.

(3) The Committee shall act as a liaison for the Village in relation to other governmental agencies dealing with transportation issues within the Village.

(4) Traffic Code. The Committee shall recommend revisions to the Village's Traffic Code.

(5) Traffic Studies. The Committee shall review, and make recommendations in regard to, traffic studies affecting traffic within the Village.

(6) Complaints. The Committee shall review, and make recommendations in regard to, all complaints received by the Village relative to traffic and/or parking issues.

(7) Circulator. The Committee shall have the responsibility of reviewing, reporting upon and making recommendations on issues associated with the Circulator.

(8) The Committee shall consider other matters which are specifically referred to it by the corporate authorities.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
