**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING TITLE IX,
CHAPTER 98, SECTION 98.01 THROUGH 98.04 OF
THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO TAXATION**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That, in enacting this Ordinance, the President and Board of Trustees hereby waive and supersede the provisions of Title IX, Chapter 98, Section 98.04 of the Lombard Village Code.

SECTION 2: That Title IX, Chapter 98, Sections 98.01 through 98.04 of the Lombard Village Code are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval, as provided by law.
