Re: Intergovernmental Agreement with Glenbard Township High School District

87

Glenbard High School District 87 has asked that the Village of Lombard enter into an intergovernmental agreement with them. District 87 is seeking to enter into similar agreements with all governmental agencies where their four respective high schools are located. If the Village Board should approve this agreement, they will have three of the four schools covered by the same agreement.

The agreement largely formalizes the relationship we currently have with the District and Glenbard East High School. As you know, we currently assign a full-time detective to serve as a liaison officer at Glenbard East. This is a valuable relationship for both the police department and the high school. District 87 does reimburse the Village on a prorated basis for the services of the officer. The agreement provides a general description of the liaison officer's job duties and the services he or she provides. It also provides a framework for the Village Manager and the District Superintendent to agree on compensation for the position.

The final component of the Agreement is to formalize the reciprocal reporting of information between the police department and the District as it relates to criminal offenses. We have worked with the District on mutually agreeable language for the entire agreement. It has been reviewed and approved by the District's attorneys and Village legal counsel. This part of the Agreement largely formalizes the practice that is currently in place and is authorized under Illinois law.
