FY2007 and FY2008 Resident Engineering Short-List

Every two years, Public Works Engineering re-establishes the engineering short-lists for professional services related to Resident Engineering, Design Engineering, and Hydraulics and Hydrology. Staff has completed the qualifications based selection process for the Resident Engineering Short-List. A total of fourteen firms received the Request for Qualifications and Proposals, and eleven firms submitted Statements of Qualifications to be considered for the Resident Engineering Short-List.

The following six firms, listed in alphabetical order, comprise the Resident Engineering Short-List for FY2007 and FY2008, and will be eligible to submit proposals for resident engineering services over the next two years:

Christopher B. Burke Engineering, LTD
Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company, Inc.
Civiltech Engineering, Inc.
Engineering Resource Associates, Inc.
K-Plus Engineering, LTD
V3 Infrastructure Services, LTD

Performance of the firms will be evaluated after FY2007, and with satisfactory performance, the firms will continue to be eligible for work thru FY2008.

Of the firms on the list, only K-Plus Engineering, LTD is new to the Short-List. However, the firm's principle and several staff members have previously worked on Village projects while employed by other firms and so are familiar with the Village's expectations.
