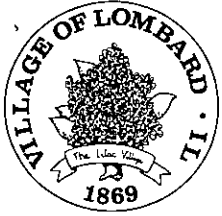

Subject: Recommendations from the Transportation and Safety Committee

The Transportation and Safety Committee, at their February 5th meeting, voted unanimously to approve the following items:

- **070053– No parking:** South side of 16th Street from Main Street to Highland Avenue. This issue was requested by a resident on Charlotte Court. Parking on both sides of the road poses a passing hazard. Letters were sent to area residents as well as Christ the King Church and School. No comments were received.
- **060714– No parking:** South side of Morris Avenue from School Street to Westmore/Meyers Road. This issue was requested by the owners affected by the “No Parking” restriction. Parking on both sides of the road poses a passing hazard due to the rural cross-section of the road and the pavement width of twenty-eight (28) feet. Also, delineators will be placed at the corners of Morris Avenue and mid-block to prevent motorists from driving in the ditch.

Please present this item to the Board of Trustees at their regularly scheduled meeting on March 15, 2007 in accordance with the Committee’s recommendation.

The following sections of the traffic code require an ordinance:

SCHEDULE VII - PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS

In accordance with Section 10-13-6 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall, at any time, park a vehicle upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:

16th Street - South side; From: Main Street; To: Highland Avenue
Morris Avenue – South side; From: School Street; To: Westmore/Meyers Road

ORDINANCE NO. _____

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule VII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS be amended to add the following thereto:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
16 th Street, south side	Main Street	Highland Avenue
Morris Avenue, south side	School Street	Westmore/Meyers Road

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
